



Step 1

Download the Freegal app from your device's app store

Step 2

Open Freegal app

Type in your zip code or city (or allow the app to find your location", tap **Continue**, then select **Buffalo and Erie County Public Library** from the list

Step 3

Enter your library card number & PIN. Tap **Log in**



Step 4

You can scroll through the Featured (Home) section, or select the options at the bottom of your screen:

Browse and **Search**. Each section gives new options at the top of the screen, such as, New Arrivals, Genres, Artists, and more



Step 5

To download a song, tap on the three dots on the right and select **Download**

To stream a song, tap on the play icon on top of the album artwork, a gray bar will appear at the bottom of your screen, tap the up arrow to control the stream
